

# Human Body Newsletter – Biology 2003

The Human Body Newsletter is a series of reports on the various systems of the human body, such as the muscular system, the skeletal system, etc. One system will be due approximately every month until the end of school. At that point, they will all be put together in a coherent manner with an appropriate title page which will include a table of contents, printed out and turned in for a final grade. The information for the Travel Newsletter of the Human Body is on my web site at **schmickrath.com**. All information referring to a group project can be ignored, as that refers to a different class. In Biology, this is an individual exploration of the Human Body. The systems will be done and graded individually in the following order with the listed due dates:

1. Skeletal System – Oct 31
2. Muscular System – Nov 28
3. Nervous System – Dec 18
4. Respiratory System – Jan 28
5. Circulatory System – Feb 26
6. The Senses – Mar 25
7. The Endocrine System – April 28
8. Digestive System – May 25
9. The Immune System – June 4

The above sections are each worth 25 points. **The whole newsletter is due on June 8<sup>th</sup>**. Each section will be printed out and turned in for a progress grade. The entire newsletter will be printed out with a title page that includes a table of contents and your name. It will be put in an appropriate holder and turned in for a final overall grade. The overall project is worth 100 points.

You should store the sections of your newsletter on at least 2 different disks. If you only have one copy, and it for some reason cannot be read, you will have to re-do everything you have already done. I would suggest at least 3 different copies.

The final copy to be turned in will be in a newsletter format. This can be created with Microsoft Publisher which is available on most of the computers in the Library ( Media Center ). Save it on at least 2 disks, and then e-mail a copy to yourself at home. For the final product you will merge all systems into a coherent newsletter with a common theme to it, and add a title page that includes a table of contents and your name.
